The 6th National Preachers Conference was conducted at Shinshicho, Kambatta from November 5th through November 9th. Seven hundred preachers, church leaders and members came from all over southern Ethiopia. Shinshicho is located in the heart land of the church and many members from that area came during the day and were not included in number mentioned. It was an uplifting and an exciting time of renewal for all who were there. Preaching brethren who were trained together and had not seen one another for many years

enjoyed being together and talking about their mutual ministries. Congregations from all over the Badewatcho and Kambatta area served as hosts and did an outstanding job of organizing the program, preparing three meals a day for everyone and making sure there was a place to sleep for all who came from other places.

NEW AGREEMENT SIGNED FOR 40 NEW WATER WELLS:





We have signed a new water well agreement with the Water Bureau of the Southern Region and UNICEF for 40 new wells. 20 in the Kambatta Zone and 20 in the Badewatcho, Zone. Both these areas are in desperate need of clean water. The Lord's Church is

strong in these areas and thousands of our members will have access to these new wells. We are very thankful to have been given this opportunity. Drilling should have started by the time you receive this newsletter. Pray for success in finding water at every drill site, for the safety of our crew and that our 1967 drilling rig will once again perform to the standard it has in the last 550 wells drilled. We were promised 20 additional wells, but because government geologists were not able to get into that area to select the sites, those will have to wait until the next round.
