Current Sudanese Church leaders in Calgary, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, South Sudan,

Uganda and the USA originated from the Kabana Church. Some of these men and women have become nurses, doctors, administrators in various non-governmental agencies, directors of Preaching Schools and many other leading positions in their respective areas where they were resettled by the U.N. Hundreds of souls have been reached because of men like Roger, Peter Tute, Daniel, James, Khor and John Jock. These men are still very faithful serving God wherever God has sent them and allowed them to live. The Word of God has continued to spread because of these men, and others, were trained and well equipped in the scripture.
