THE ADDIS ABABA BIBLE TRAING SCHOOL HAS STARTED:







The two-year bible training course has started at the mission compound in Addis Ababa. A great need for well-trained leaders in the Lord's work there prompted the planning for this new school. On the left, Brother Jim Wilson is shown leading a final planning session for those who will be the instructors for the first session of the studies. All the students were given new laptops loaded with hundreds of bible lessons both in English and Amharic, study materials, research books, hymns, and other information useful for their ministry. ANOTHER WELL COMPLETED ON THE ADDIS ABABA COMPOUND:







The drilling crew has completed another producing well on the compound in Addis Ababa. This third well was necessary because the second well drilled collapsed and the water it produced was not good. Also, its production was low. The new well is located between the two top houses. The carport had to be removed and will be replaced after the well is completed. On the right, Monte and Solomon are pictured with the pump that has been installed on the new well. It was set at 133 feet because it was too small to pump from the bottom of the well. It provides 12 gallons per minute at this time and will fill up several storage tanks for use in the school and other needs on the compound. It will be replaced when a new deep-water pump arrives from the states. The Addis Ababa municipal water supply isn't dependable and at times is off for several days. We are very thankful for these two good wells. And we are thankful for the hard work our crew did in drilling these wells. Much of the drilling was done through solid rock.

A BEAUTIFUL WAY OF TEACHING MINISTRY IN ETHIOPIA:



Brother Behailu is pictured here in the evening hours standing before the student body of the new bible training school. Behailu's 60 years of ministry and of building the work in Ethiopia stands as a monumental example for these younger men.
