BEHAILU REPORTS ABOUT A GOSPEL MEETING IN JAJURA:









The Jajura School of Preaching compound has been the gathering place for the congregations in the regions around it for more than 30 years. Because of the problems caused by the Covid epidemic as well as the continuing unrest making travel on the major highways impossible, gatherings haven't been held. The church leaders and preachers in that area using the encouragement of several of the Addis Ababa Bible Training Institute (AABTI) students planned and conducted a three-day conference. Behailu reports that it was attended by more than 1000 people. Some walked for more than 8 hours from their homes to attend.

Pictured on the left is Brother Walde Ghorghis standing in front of the tent structure where the people met. The second picture was taken at one of the assemblies. Two of the leading organizers were Brothers Lopiso and Behailu. Both these brethren are students at the AABTI. Lopiso is also the son of Walde Ghorghis. Seven preachers took part in bringing the lessons. Bro. Behailu was unable to attend because of the travel restrictions so they set up a telephone conference line using a PA system in the tent and Behailu was able to bring a lesson using that technology. Everyone was blessed and encouraged!

Behailu reports that this conference was a big encouragement for the thousands of members living in the areas around Jajura and in distant areas far away. God has been praised and the spirits of the people have been lifted.
