

Hope you all are doing well, below is a brief report of the Kingdom work in Ethiopia.

My trip to Ethiopia is good and for the past four days I have been meeting with the brethren about the upcoming Preachers conference and graduation program, the completed 60nwells and the medical clinic activity. We all are looking forward to the preachers' conference for fellowship, encouragement, sharing of the word and praising our God in songs.

The 60 water well project is completed and we are awaiting a final report from the Hawassa water bureau. Once we receive the evaluation and completion letter from the office, we are planning to work on the proposal for the next well drilling project. On the current project we had 20 young men from the district where the water wells were drilled who expressed interest to attend a Bible Training school and want to know more about the Church of Christ. We conducted two 3 months of preachers training school for these 20 young men and now they are working near their village on planting new congregations.

Our medical clinic is not only helping people with health issues but, also becoming instrument to share the good news with people who visit. The community near and far the clinic knows about the service provided and when they became aware that the clinic is under the Church of Christ, they start asking what we teach. The Addis Ababa congregation minster and servants of the kingdom are communicating with these people, and it is our prayer that souls will be saved, and God will be glorified.

#### Build For the Future (BFF)

The winter season brought unforeseen delays, impacting our timeline. Flooding and bad road conditions made it difficult for trucks to deliver materials and slower construction pace. In addition to the winter season Ethiopian New year holiday and the subsequent holidays since the first of the new year, impacted the pace because workers had to travel to countryside to be with family and friends. However, despite the challenges, we have made significant progress. As we are transitioning to summer dry season, we anticipate a significant acceleration in the construction pace. This period will allow us to catch up on lost time and move forward more efficiently. we are confident that the coming months will see substantial progress.
